

U A Roping Team Winners



University of Arizona's roping team won the William N. Porter trophy, at the second annual invitational college roping contests held during the Arizona Livestock Show at Phoenix.

All three universities in the state were invited to take part, but only the U of A and ASU participated, with NAU bowing out. Each school fielded a four-man team, each individual roping two calves and each school also fielding two teams of two-men team ropers. ASU, which took the traveling trophy last year, yielded it to the U of A ropers this year.
